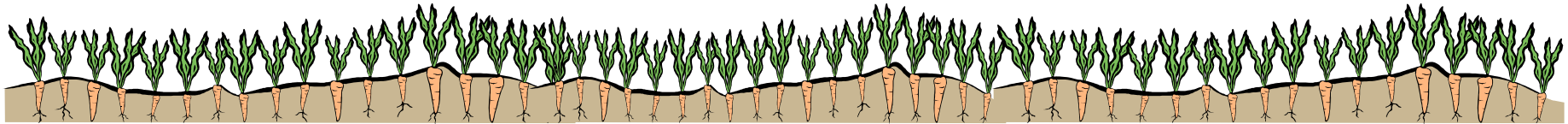

(When requested, we buy specialty seeds for our gardeners from different cultures.)
- B. Putting A Garden To Bed \$15**
(Manure and cover crop builds healthy soil.)
- C. Soil Lead Testing \$25**
(All garden sites are tested for soil lead content.)
- D. 15 pairs kids' sized gardening gloves \$25**
(Cold winter mud isn't fun for little hands!)
- E. Garden Workshop-3 Gardeners \$50**
(Includes materials, rental, handouts, and teacher.)
- F. Garden Tool Set of 3 \$75**
(Hoes, rakes, shovels, hoses, gloves and more.)
- G. A disabled access bed \$100**
(This covers al the lumber, hardware and soil for a higher, wood frame bed with a bench around the top)
- H. One Youth Grow after-school class \$250**
(Each two-hour class includes an age-appropriate mix of physical activity, gardening, games and a fresh-food snack that the children often help prepare.)
